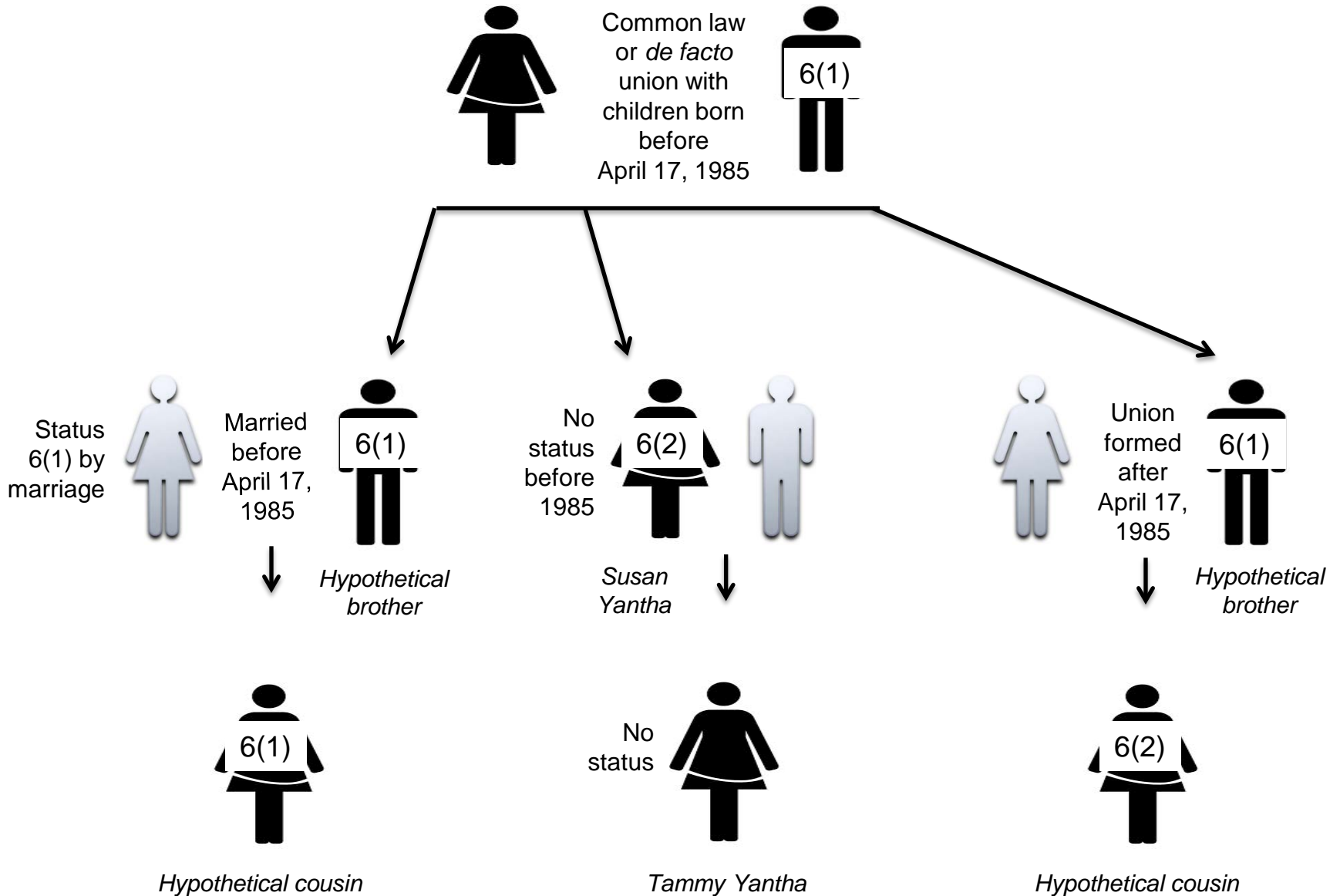


Passing on status under the *Indian Act* since 1985

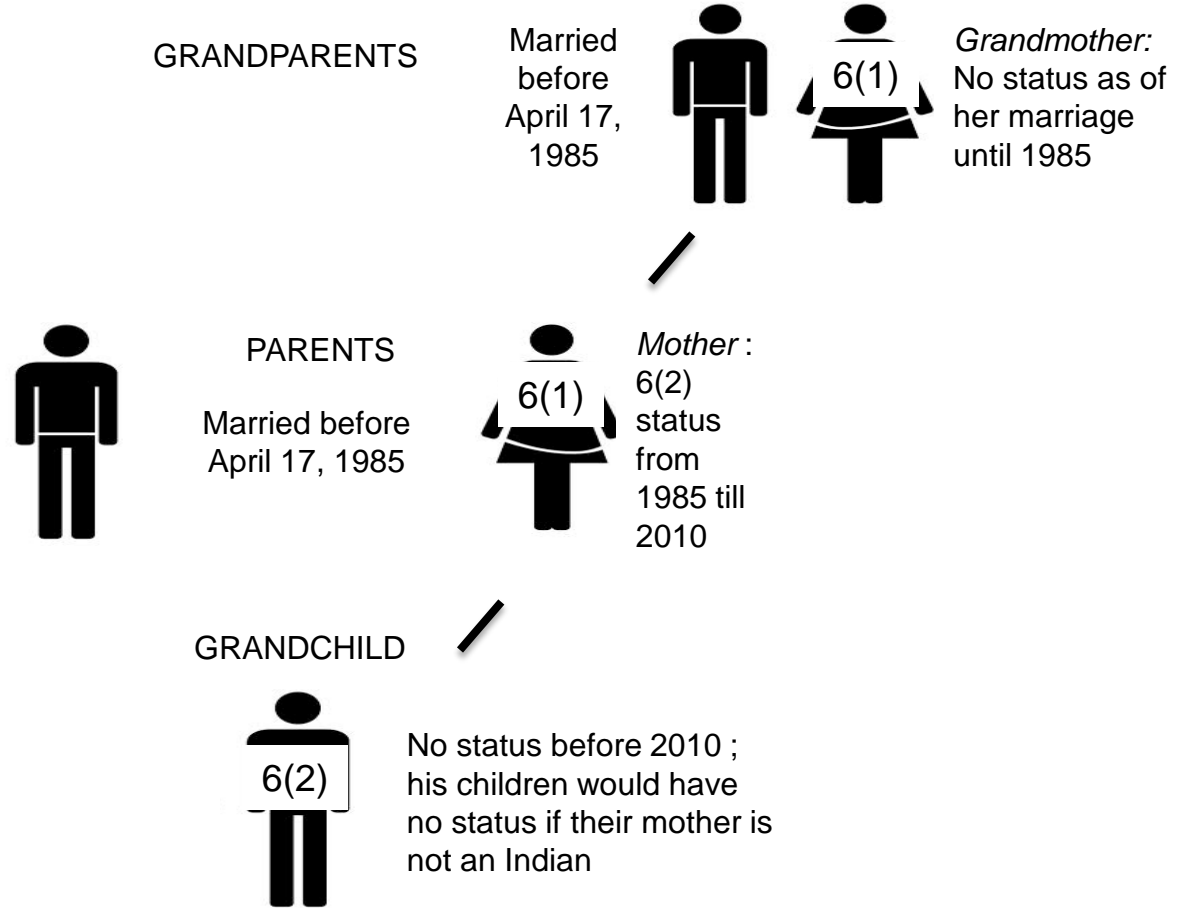
6(1) + 6(1) parents ↓ 6(1) child		6(1) + 6(2) parents ↓ 6(1) child
	6(1) + non-status parent ↓ 6(2) child	
6(2) + 6(2) parents ↓ 6(1) child		6(2) + non-status parents ↓ non-status child

Explanation: under section 6(1) of the *Indian Act*, status can always be transmitted to a registered Indian's children but under section 6(2), status cannot be transmitted if the other parent is not also a registered Indian.
