HOW DOES IT WORK?

SCHEDULE

- Open from May to November.
- · Closing at the first snow accumulation on the ground.
- Closed on Tuesday following a holiday (Wednesday during the fall schedule).

BRINGING RESIDUES

Simply show up during opening hours with your materials and be able to unload them yourself.

- I. Immobilize the vehicle and identify yourself with an official document with address.
- 2. The attendant will check your materials and let you know where to unload.
- 3. Unload yourself, following the instructions of the attendant.

There is no quantity limit.

TAKING RESIDUES

As a member of Odanak, you have the opportunity to take resources available at the ecocenter: sand, gravel, wood, etc. Availability is based on the residues that were brought in and is therefore never guaranteed and is self-service (you must load the materials, trim the wood if necessary, etc.).

REGULATIONS



Do not use the ecocentre outside of opening hours



Do not use machinery or a tipping trailer



Do not detach the safety guardrail



Do not go down into the container



Do not smoke on the site



Do not hunt on the site



The speed limit on the site is 10 km/h



Young children and pets must stay inside vehicles

ACCEPTED MATERIALS



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE IN IDENTIFIED CONTAINERS OF 20 LITRES OR LESS (5 GALLONS)

 Acids, lightbulbs and fluorescents, bases, batteries and cells, fuels, oils, oxidants, paints, aerosol products, toxic products, propane.



AGGREGATES

• Concrete, asphalt, sand, gravel, stone.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND SOME OVERSIZED ITEMS

 Brick, ceramic, gypsum, glass, mineral wool, shingle, linoleum, wood, plastic, baths, showers, furnitures, pool liners, etc.

METALS

APPLIANCES CONTAINING REFRIGERANT GAS OR NOT

 Refrigerators, air conditioning, freezers, washers, dryers, stoves, hoods, etc.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES AND COMPUTING DEVICES

MATTRESSES AND UPHOLSTERED FURNITURES

• Armchairs, sofas, futon cushions.

TIRES

• Without rims, diameter less than 48 in.

CLEAN, FUNCTIONAL AND UNDAMAGED FURNITURE THAT CAN BE REUSED

USED EYEGLASSES

GARDENING RESIDUES

 Grass clippings, branches, stumps, soil.

CHILDREN'S CAR SEAT





REFUSED MATERIALS



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE STORED IN CONTAINERS OF MORE THAN 20 LITRES (5 GALLONS) OR UNIDENTIFIED

ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND PRODUCTS FROM INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL OR INSTITUTIONAL ACTIVITIES

• Including agricultural business materials such as plastics.

WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION

PICRIC ACID



HYDROFLUORIC ACID

ASBESTOS IN ANY FORM

PCBS (POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYL)
AND ANY PRODUCTS THAT MAY
CONTAIN THEM

CREOSOTE-TREATED OR TARRED WOOD



CYANIDE IN ANY FORM

BIOMEDICAL WASTE

• Syringes, catheters, animal carcasses.



PATHOLOGICAL WASTE AND RADIOACTIVE WASTE

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

UNSUITABLE TIRES

CONTAMINATED SOIL

• E. g. by fuel.

THORIUM NITRATE

 Old incandescent sleeves, some TIG welding electrodes.

CLOTHING

SOME COMPLEX ITEMS

• Such as hot-tubs (jacuzzi) and structures not separated by material (e. g. a whole shed). Items that are too large may be accepted if they are split beforehand).

INVASIVE EXOTIC PLANTS

 Such as Japanese knotweed and phragmites.
